
Right Angle Weave

With a single strand and leaving an 18-inch tail:

String 12 (size 11) beads and tie them into a circle. Pass the needle back through the beads on Side 1 and 2. String 9 more beads and pass back through (PBT) sides 2, 5 and 6. When you're finished with THIS STEP, the needle and thread will be coming UP from Section 6. String 9 more beads. Pass needle through sections 6, 8 and 9. When you're finished with THIS STEP, the needle and thread will be coming DOWN from Section 9.

Continue these steps until you've got 27 "windows" of right angle weave and have completed one entire row of the bracelet.

After completing the 27th "window" of your bracelet your needle should be coming DOWN beads 1, 2 and 3. Pass your needle through beads 4, 5 and 6. String 9 beads (7-15) and PT beads 4, 5 and 6. Then PT beads 7, 8 and 9. String 6 more beads (#16-21) and PT beads A, B and C of the first row. PT beads 7, 8 and 9 and then through beads 16 through 21. PT beads D, E and F of the first row.

String 6 more beads (#22-27). PT beads 19 through 21 and then through beads D, E and F of the first row. and then through beads 22 through

Continue adding six beads at a time and working back to the beginning of the bracelet. When you reach the beginning, add Row 3 in the same manner.

Note: Stitches go from a clockwise direction to a counter-clockwise direction as you work along a row.

When you've completed all three rows, add surface embellishments, loops and closures.
