


# SQUARE STITCH

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PT - Pass through

**Step 1:** Thread and condition a comfortable length of thread. Using a single strand and leaving a 12-inch tail, string on a tension bead. 

Pass through the tension bead once or twice being VERY CAREFUL not to split the thread. CHECK that this bead is movable as it will be removed shortly.

**DO NOT COUNT THE TENSION BEAD IN THE BEAD COUNT.**

## Step 2:

(A) String seed beads needed for row width. PT the 2nd to the last bead strung. PT the last bead strung.

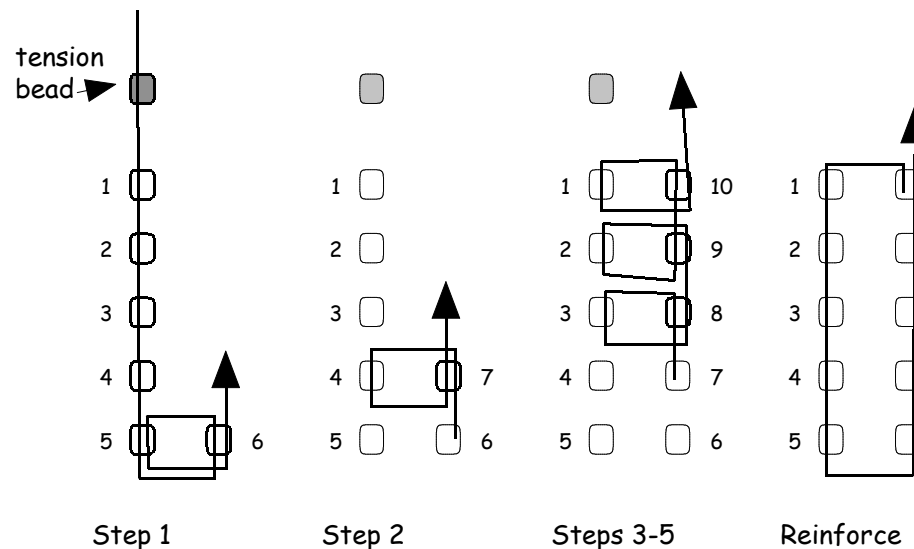
(B) String 1 seed bead (7th). PT seed bead #4 from Step 2 PT the 7th bead strung (this step).

(C) Repeat stringing one bead at a time and passing through the bead adjacent to it in the previous row.

## REMOVE THE STOPPER BEAD

(D) PT all beads in the previous row and then in the current row. Arrange work so the working thread is at the bottom right.

Repeat Step 2 to add more rows.



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
