NOTES:

1. CULL the RD and SD Beads to ensure that BOTH HOLES are OPEN
2. RD = RounDuo; SD = Super Duo; SB = Size 11 Seed Beads; sb = Size 15 seed beads
3. PT (pass through) in the same direction as the previous pass(es); PBT (pass back through) in the opposite direction as previous pass(es)
4. FADED BEADS AND LINES indicate the previous step(s)
5. WEAVE in new thread(s) as needed, securing with half-hitch knots
6. CULL the sbs and Crystals; use those of consistent shape and size. Discard beads with broken, jagged or unusually sharp edges
7. The sides of the crystals and bugle beads are very sharp. Take care when PT or PBT to avoid breaking or fraying thread

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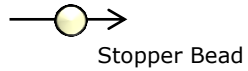

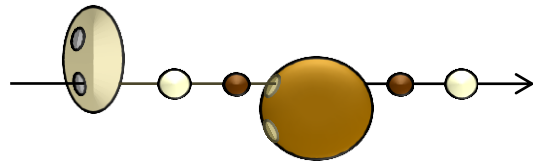
A: THREAD: The Fireline (See Note 5; Page 1);

B: STRING: One Size 11 SB



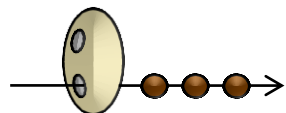
C: PT: The Stopper Bead again leaving a 6-inch tail

One Size 11 SB



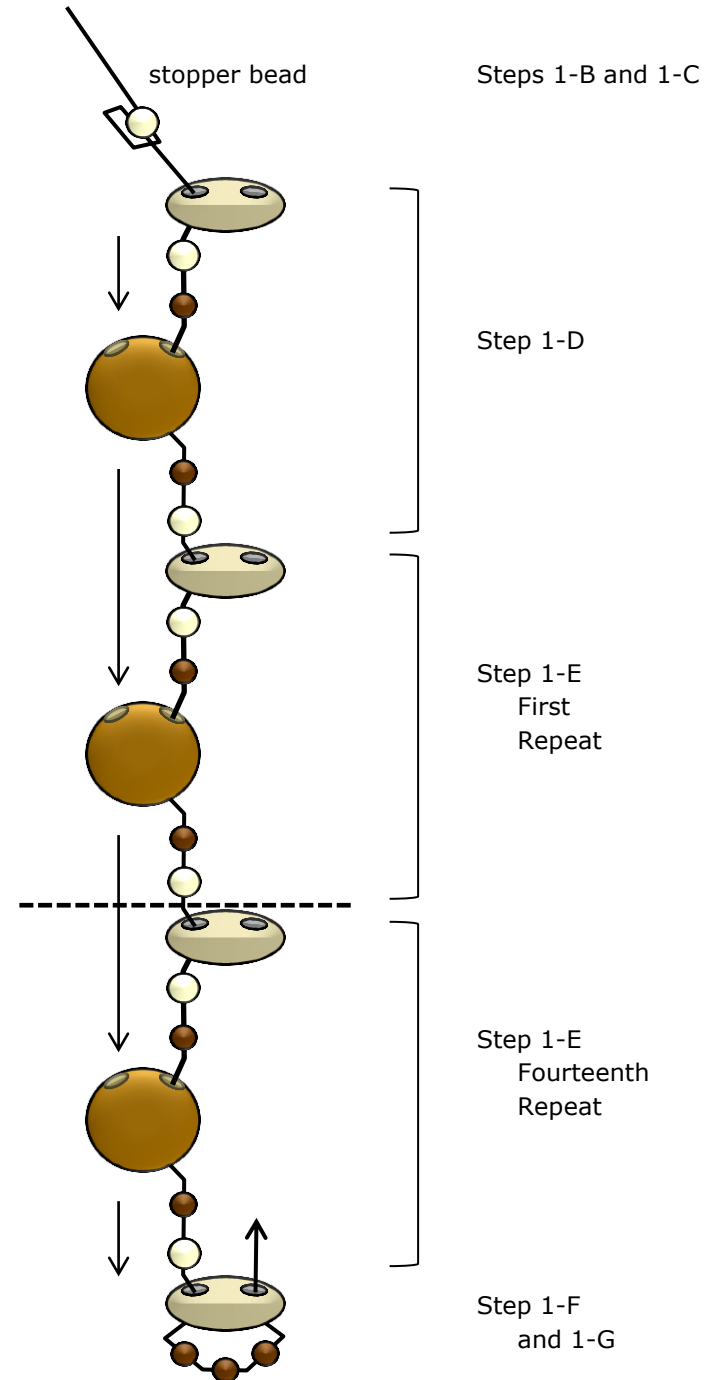
E: REPEAT: STEP 1-D FOURTEEN MORE TIMES
For a TOTAL of 90 Beads strung,
Using 15 RD Beads and 15 SD Beads
Bead Count DOES NOT include the stopper bead

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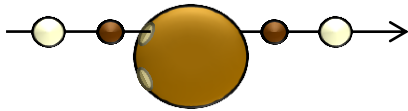
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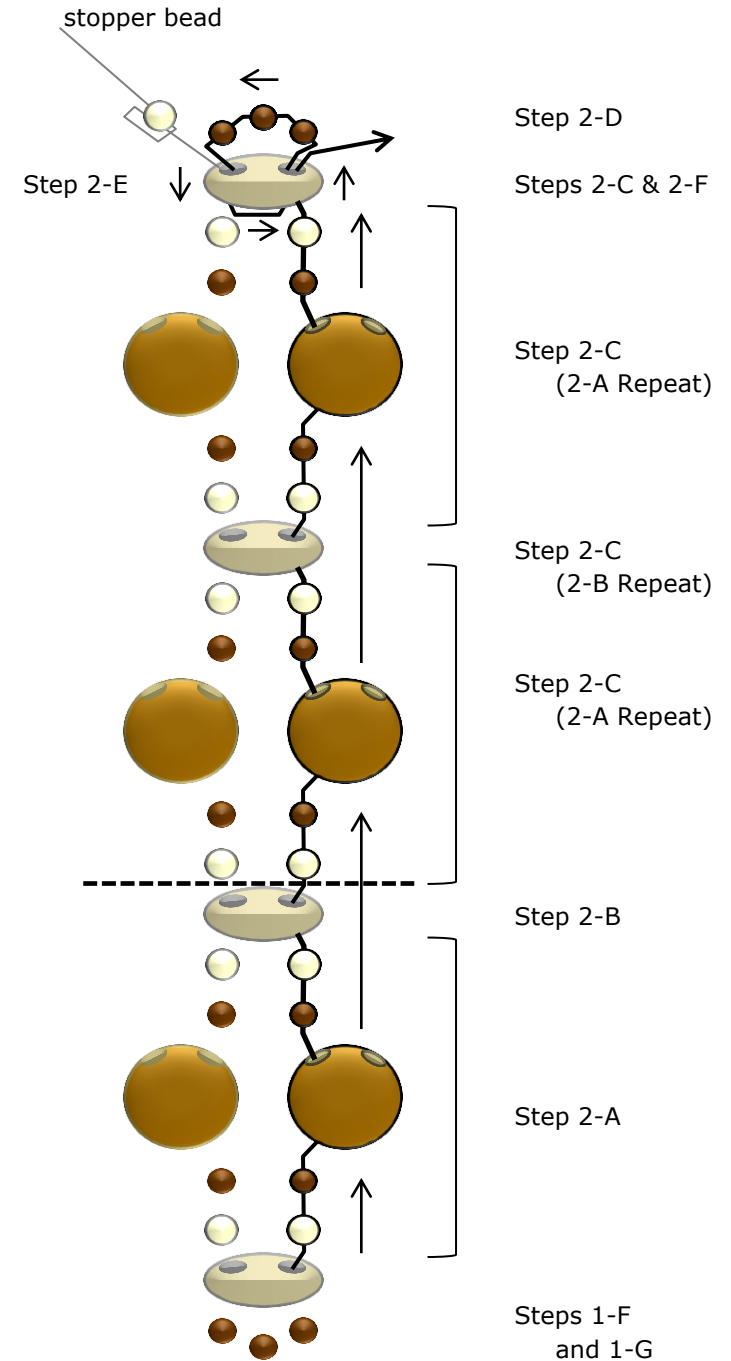
Step 2: Base - Center Right

One Size 15 sb
One RoundDuo Bead
One Size 15 sb
One Size 11 SB



- B:** PT: The OPEN (RIGHT) Hole of the NEXT SD Bead strung in STEP 1
- C:** REPEAT: STEPS 2-A and 2-B FOURTEEN MORE TIMES
- D:** STRING: Three Size 15 sbs
- 
- E:** PT: The LEFT Hole of the SD Bead strung in STEP 1-D
- F:** PT: The RIGHT Hole of the SD Bead strung in STEP 1-D
Thread will be exposed but will not show after STEPS 5 and 6

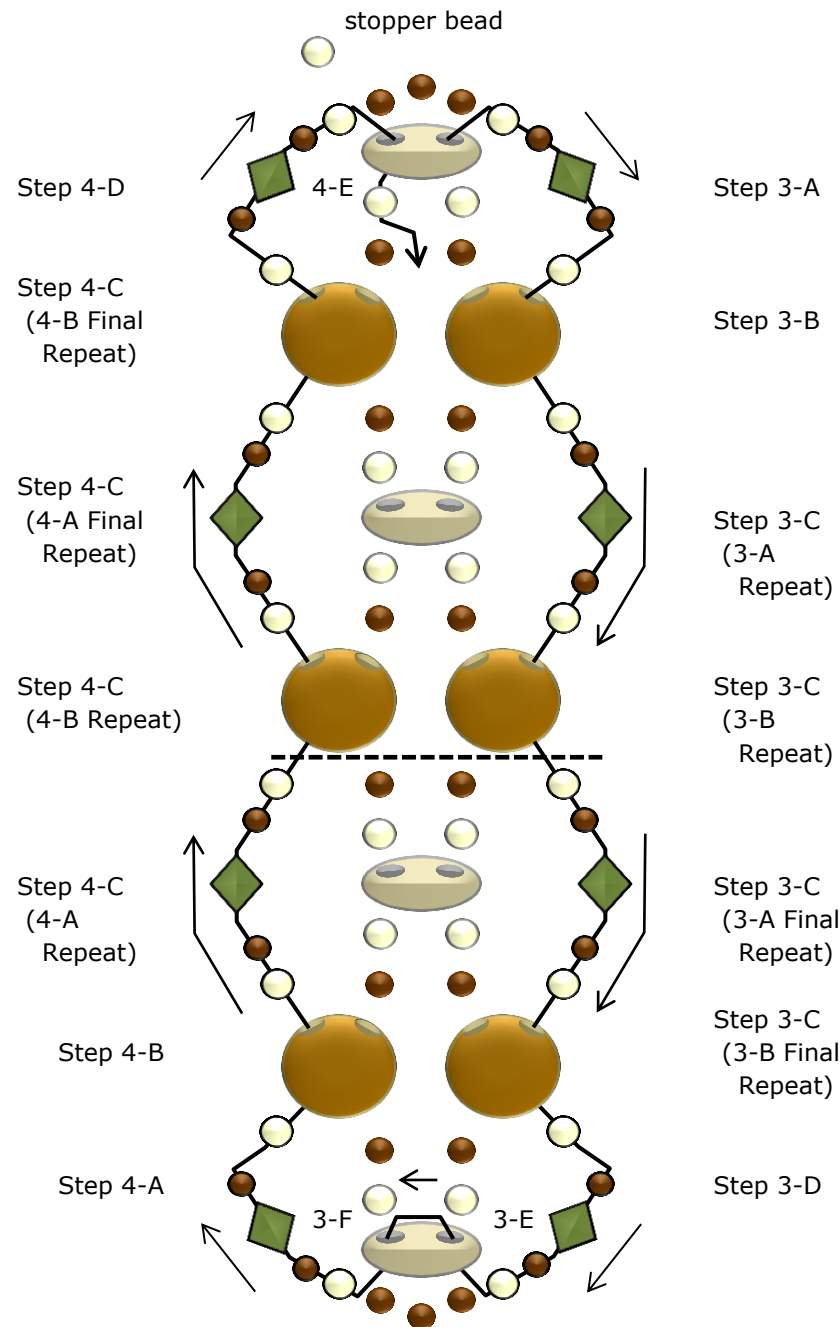


- B: PT:** The OPEN (RIGHT) Hole of the NEXT RD Bead strung in STEP 2
- C: REPEAT:** STEPS 3-A and 3-B FOURTEEN MORE TIMES
- D: REPEAT:** STEP 3-A ONE MORE TIME
- E: PT:** The RIGHT Hole of the SD Bead strung in STEP 1-F
- F: PT:** The LEFT Hole of the SD Bead strung in STEP 1-F
Thread will be exposed but will not show after STEPS 5 and 6

Step 4: Base - Left Side

Working TOWARDS the Stopper Bead:

- A: REPEAT:** STEP 3-A
- B: PT:** The OPEN (LEFT) Hole of the NEXT RD Bead strung in STEP 1
- C: REPEAT:** STEPS 4-A and 4-B FOURTEEN MORE TIMES
- D: REPEAT:** STEP 4-A ONE MORE TIME
- E: PT:** The LEFT Hole of the SD Bead and the FIRST Size 11 SB strung in STEP 1-D



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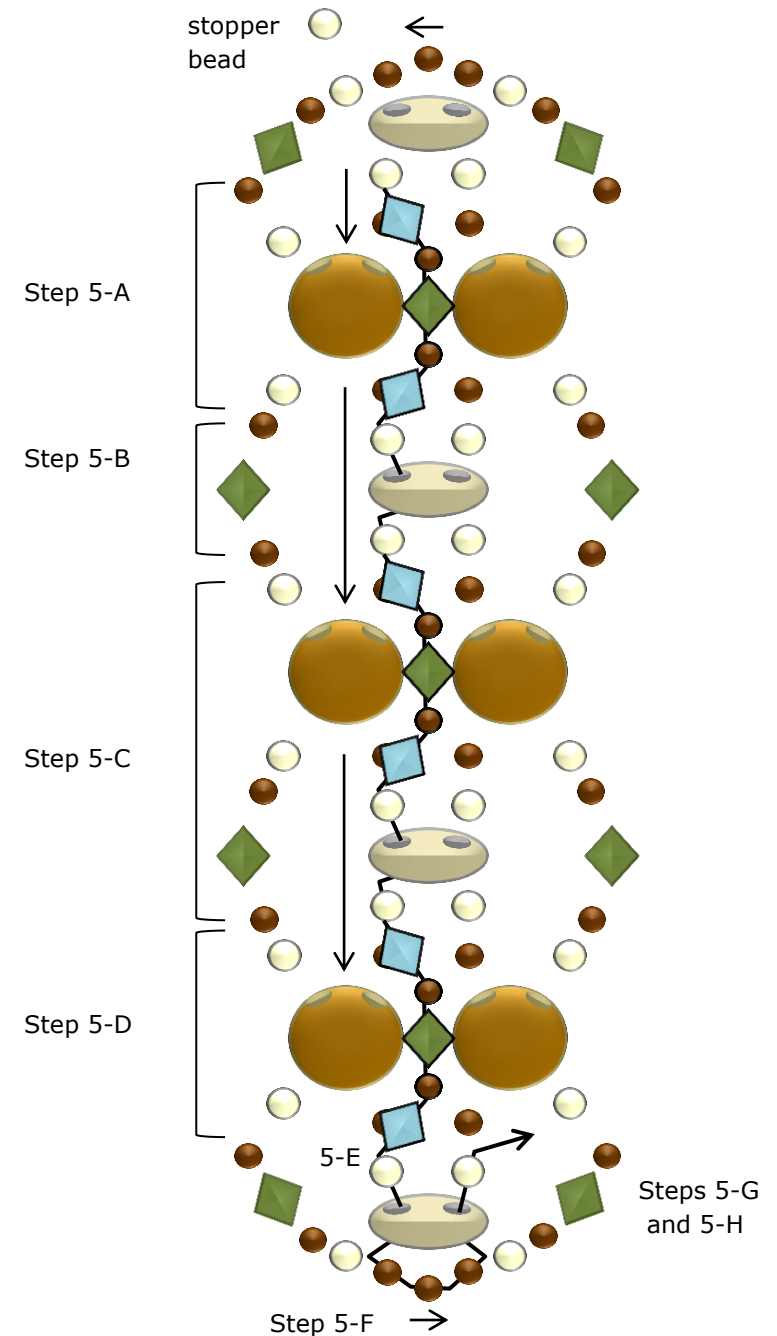
Step 5: Center Beads - Left Side

Working AWAY from the Stopper Bead:

- A:** STRING: One 3mm Opaque Turquoise Crystal
One Size 15 sb
One 3mm Peridot Satin Crystal
One Size 15 sb
One 3mm Opaque Turquoise Crystal



- B:** PT: The NEXT Size 11 SB, SD Bead (LEFT Hole) and Size 11 SB strung in STEP 1
- C:** REPEAT: STEPS 5-A and 5-B THIRTEEN MORE TIMES
- D:** REPEAT: STEP 5-A ONE MORE TIME
- E:** PT: The FINAL Size 11 SB strung in STEP 1
- F:** PT: The LEFT Hole of the SD Bead and the THREE Size 15 sbs strung in STEP 1-F
- G:** PT: The RIGHT Hole of the SD Bead strung in STEP 1-F
- H:** PT: The FIRST Size 11 SB strung in STEP 2-A

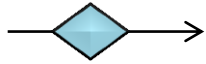

D: PT: The Next Size Size 11 SB strung in STEP 2

E: PT: The RIGHT Hole of the NEXT SD strung in STEP 1

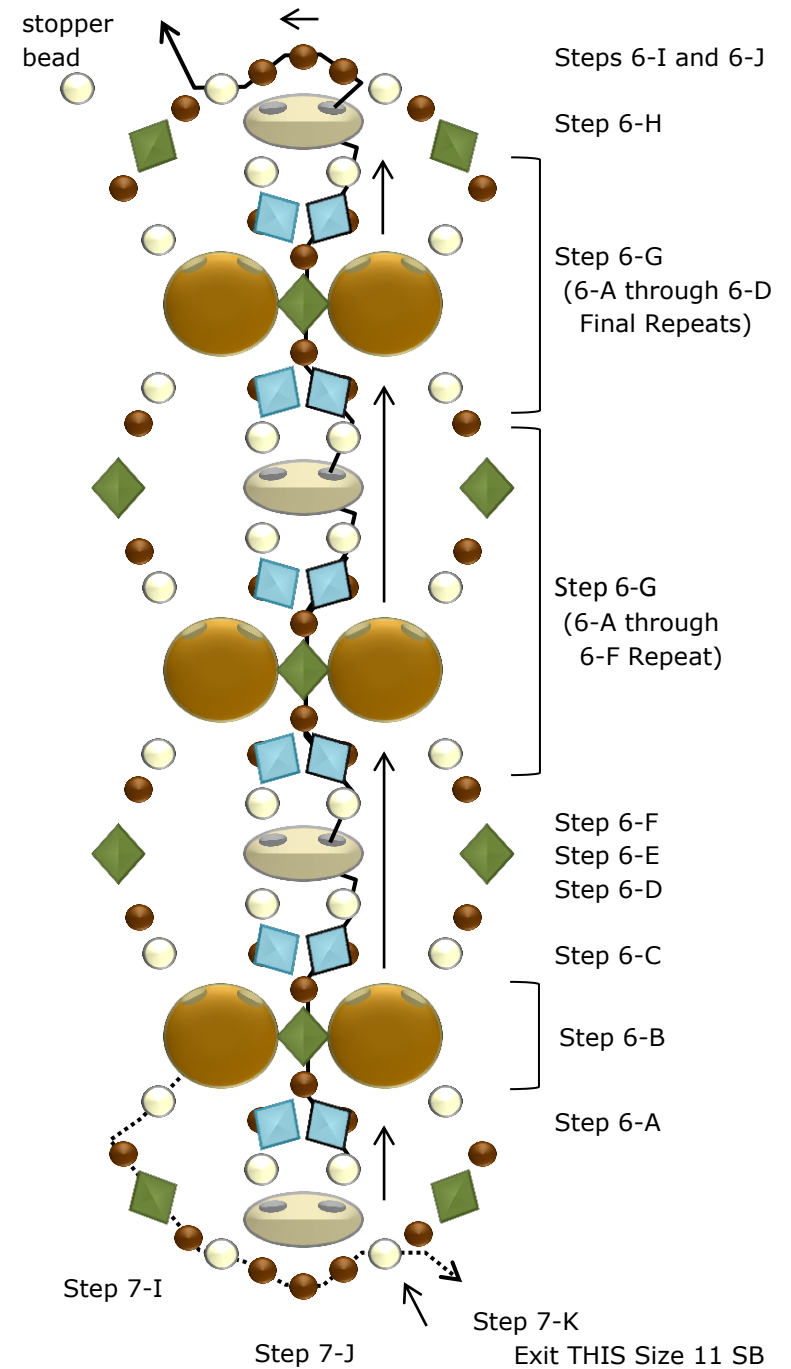
F: PT: The Next Size Size 11 SB strung in STEP 2

G: REPEAT: STEPS 6-A through 6-F FOURTEEN MORE TIMES

J: PBT: The FINAL Size 11 SB strung in STEP 4-D



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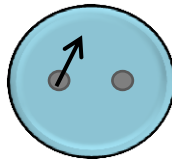
Step 7: Button

Working with the Stopper Bead on the BACK SIDE:

- A:** STRING: One Size 15 sb
One 3mm Peridot Satin Crystal
Four Size 15 sbs



- B:** STRING and PT: The LEFT HOLE of the BUTTON from BACK to FRONT

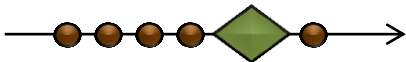


- C:** STRING: One Size 15 sb
One 3mm Peridot Satin Crystal
One Size 15 sb



- D:** PT: The RIGHT HOLE of the BUTTON from FRONT to BACK

- E:** STRING: Four Size 15 sbs
One 3mm Peridot Satin Crystal
One Size 15 sb



- F:** PBT: The FIRST Size 11 SB strung in STEP 3-A

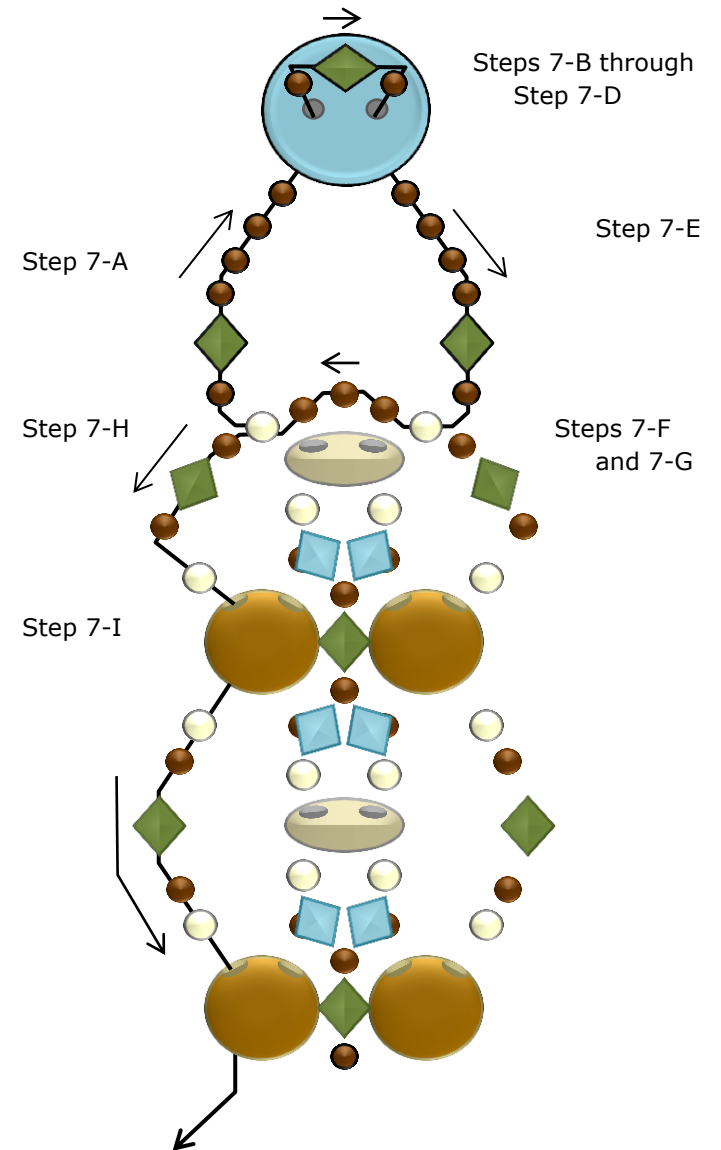
- G:** PT: The THREE Size 15 sbs strung in STEP 2-D

- H:** PBT: The FINAL Size 11 SB strung in STEP 4-D *

- I:** PBT: ■ The BEADS either STRUNG or Passed Through in STEPS 4-A through 4-D Exiting the FIRST Size 11 SB strung

- J:** PT: ■ The THREE Size 15 sbs strung in STEP 1-F

- K:** PBT: ■ The SECOND Size 11 SB strung in STEP 3-D

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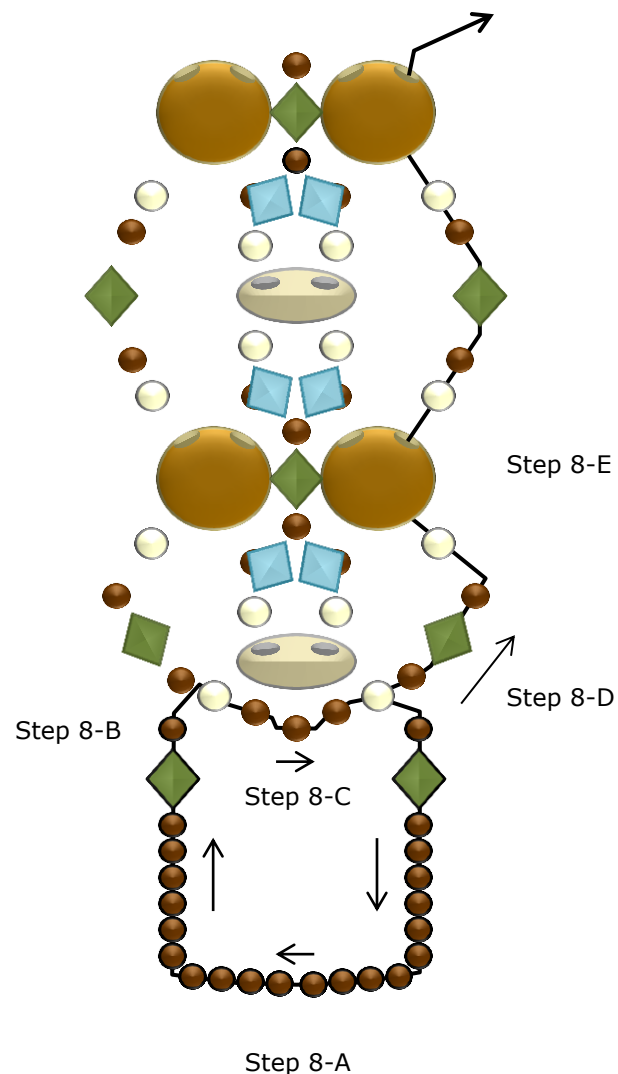
Step 8: Button Loop

- A:** STRING: One Size 15 sb
One 3mm Peridot Satin Crystal
Twenty Size 15 sbs **
One 3mm Peridot Satin Crystal
One Size 15 sb



*** Adjust the number of sbs strung to fit snugly around the button remembering that additional thread passes will tighten the loop*

- B:** PBT: The FIRST Size 11 SB strung in STEP 4-A
- C:** PT: The THREE Size 15 sbs strung in STEP 1-F
- D:** PBT: The FINAL Size 11 SB strung in STEP 3-D ***
- E:** PBT: The BEADS either STRUNG or Passed Through in STEP 3
- F:** WEAVE: In the Working Thread tying half hitch knots and weaving in the thread after the final knot. Clip the thread
- G:** REMOVE: The Stopper Bead
- H:** THREAD: The Tail Thread and pull to tighten up the beads and remove any slack in the thread
- I:** WEAVE: In the Tail Thread tying half hitch knots and weaving in the thread after the final knot. Clip the thread

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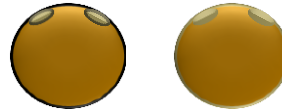

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2. RD = RounDuo; SD = Super Duo; SB = Size 11 Seed Beads; sb = Size 15 seed beads

4. FADED BEADS AND LINES indicate the previous step(s)
5. WEAVE in new thread(s) as needed, securing with half-hitch knots
6. CULL the sbs and Crystals; use those of consistent shape and size. Discard beads with broken, jagged or unusually sharp edges

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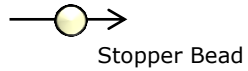

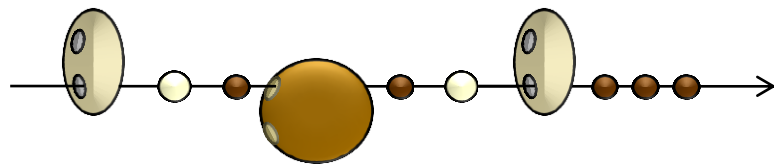

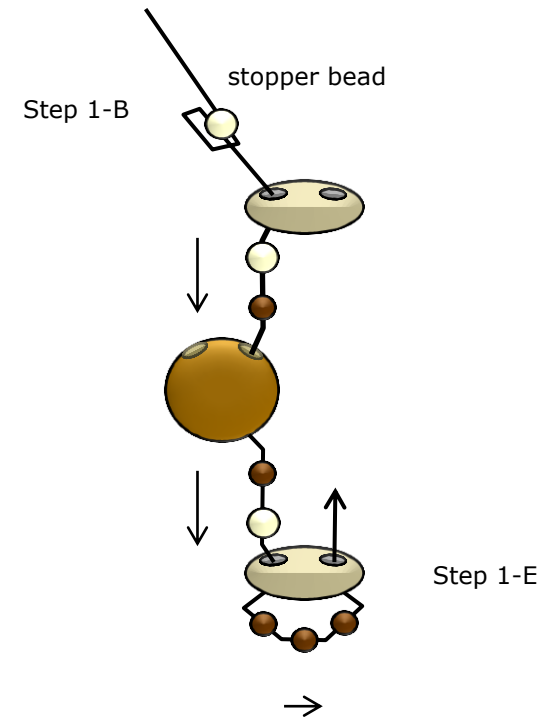


C: PT: The Stopper Bead again leaving a 6-inch tail

E: PT: The OPEN (RIGHT) Hole of the SECOND SD Bead strung in STEP 1-D



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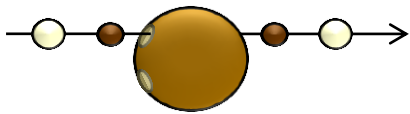

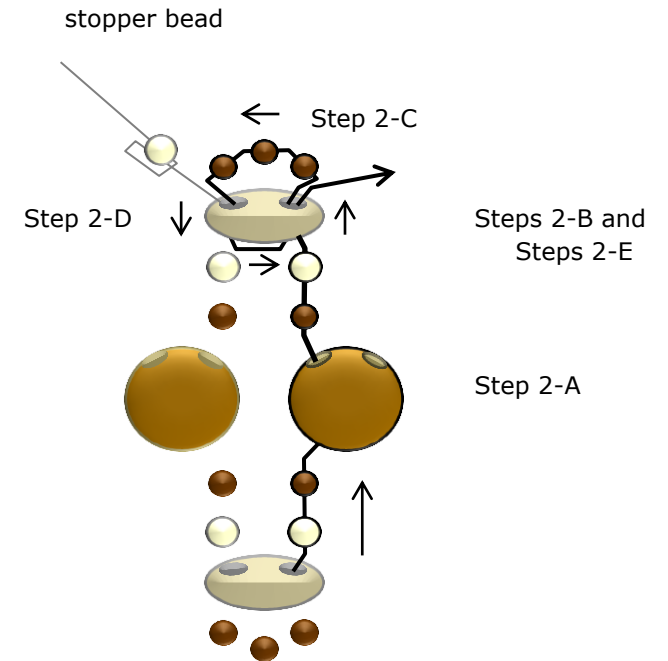
- B:** PT: The OPEN (RIGHT) Hole of the FIRST SD Bead strung in STEP 1

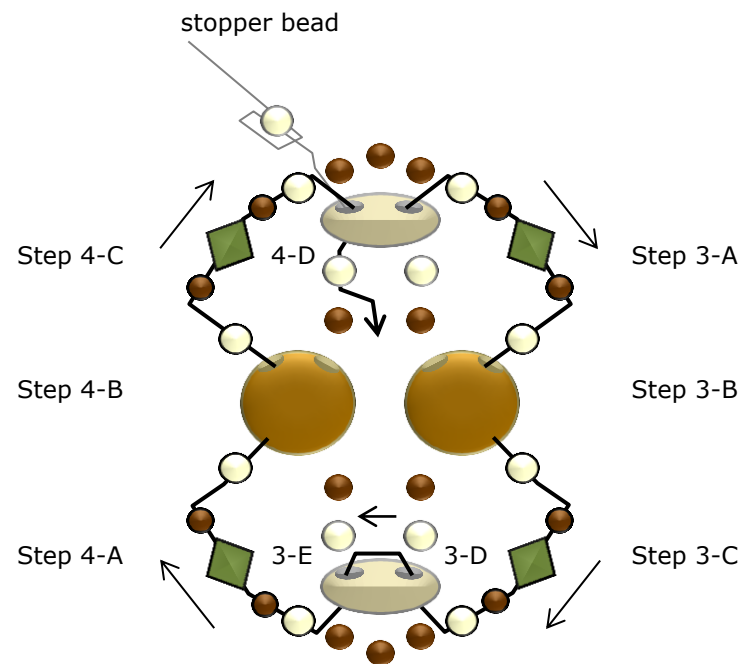

Thread will be exposed but will not show after STEPS 5 and 6

Step 4: Base - Left Side

Working TOWARDS the Stopper Bead:

- A:** REPEAT: STEP 3-A
- B:** PT: The OPEN (LEFT) Hole of the RD Bead strung in STEP 1
- C:** REPEAT: STEP 3-A
- D:** PT: The LEFT Hole of the FIRST SD Bead and the FIRST Size 11 SB strung in STEP 1



Step 5: Center Beads - Left Side

Working AWAY from the Stopper Bead:

- A:** STRING: One 3mm Opaque Turquoise Crystal
One Size 15 sb
One 3mm Peridot Satin Crystal
One Size 15 sb
One 3mm Opaque Turquoise Crystal



- B:** PT: The SECOND Size 11 SB, the LEFT Hole of the SECOND SD Bead, the THREE Size 15 sbs and the RIGHT Hole of the SECOND SD Bead strung in STEP 1

- C:** PT: The FIRST Size 11 SB strung in STEP 2

Step 6: Center Beads - Right Side

Working TOWARDS the Stopper Bead:

- A:** STRING: One 3mm Opaque Turquoise Crystal



- B:** PBT: The Size 15 sb, 3mm Crystal and Size 15 sb strung in STEP 5

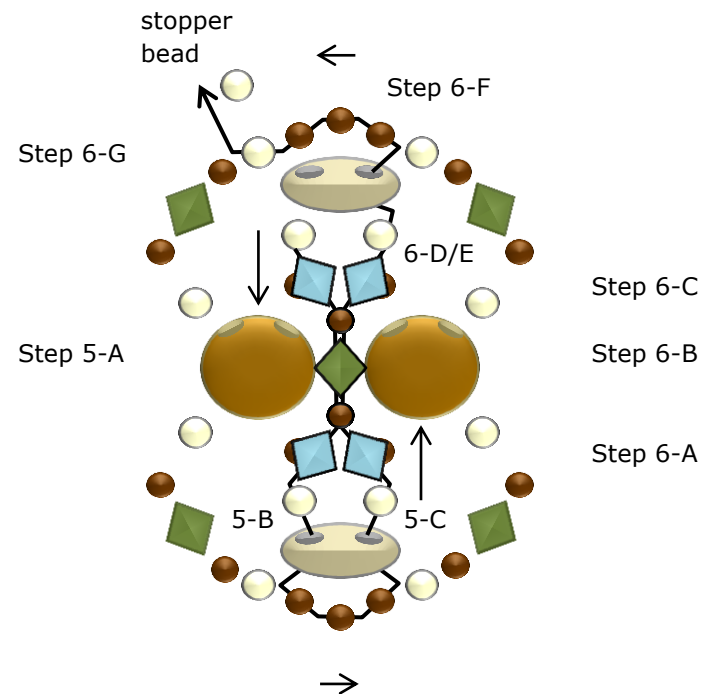
- C:** REPEAT: STEP 6-A

- D:** PT: The SECOND Size 11 SB strung in STEP 2-A

- E:** PT: The RIGHT Hole of the FIRST SD strung in STEP 1

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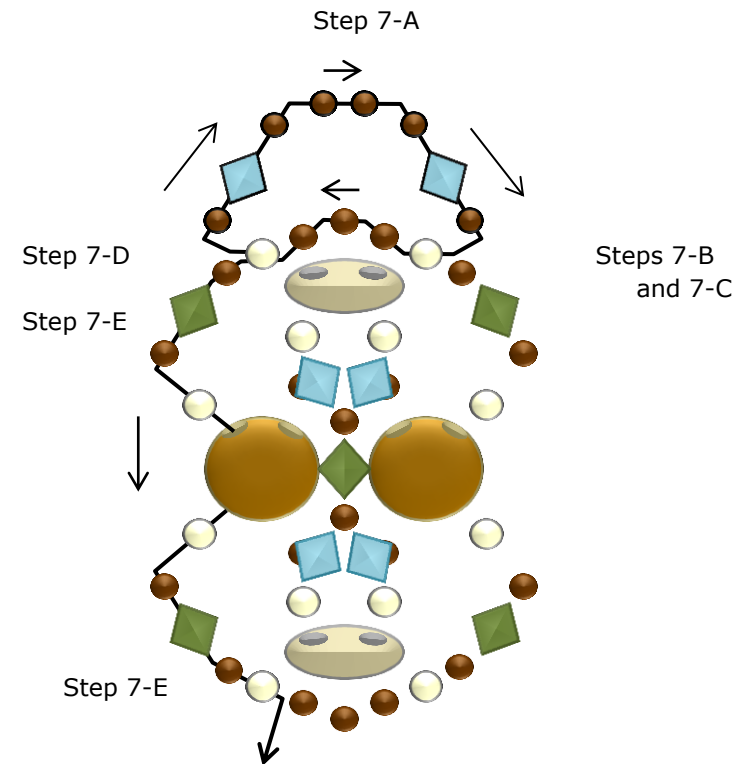
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Step 7: Earwire Loop

- A:** STRING: One Size 15 sb
One 3mm Turquoise Crystal
Four Size 15 sbs
One 3mm Turquoise Crystal
One Size 15 sb



- B:** PBT: The FIRST Size 11 SB strung in STEP 3-A
- C:** PT: The THREE Size 15 sbs strung in STEP 2-C
- D:** PBT: The SECOND Size 11 SB strung in STEP 4-C
- E:** PBT: The BEADS either STRUNG or Passed Through in STEPS 4-A through 4-C Exiting the FIRST Size 11 SB strung



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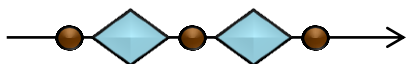
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Step 8: Bottom Embellishment

A: STRING: One Size 15 sb
One 3mm Turquoise Crystal
One Size 15 sb
One 3mm Turquoise Crystal
One Size 15 sb



B: PBT: The BEADS either STRUNG or Passed Through in STEPS 3-A through 3-C Exiting the FIRST Size 11 SB strung

C: PT: STEPS 7-B through 7-D

D: PBT: The Beads strung in STEP 7-A

E: PT: STEPS 7-B through 7-D

F: PBT: The BEADS either STRUNG or Passed Through in STEPS 4-A through 4-C Exiting the FIRST Size 11 SB strung

G: PT: The Beads strung in STEP 8-A

H: WEAVE: In the Working Thread tying half hitch knots and weaving in the thread after the final knot. Clip the thread

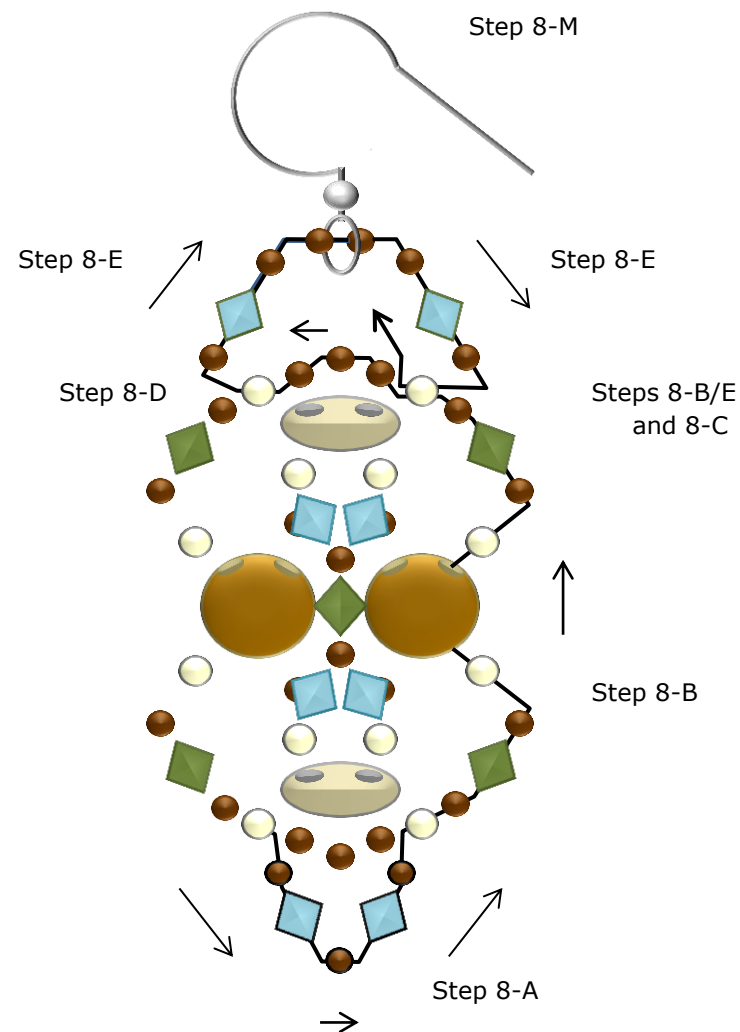
I: REMOVE: The Stopper Bead

J: THREAD: The Tail Thread and pull to tighten up the beads and remove any slack in the thread

K: WEAVE: In the Tail Thread tying half hitch knots and weaving in the thread after the final knot. Clip the thread

L: ADD: One Earwire to the TOP LOOP

M: REPEAT: STEPS 1-B through 7-L for the SECOND EARRING using the remaining Fireline
